

These instructions will tell you how to apply for a Probationary certificate, but please be aware that for it to issue after you apply:

- 1. You must pay the certificate and fingerprinting fees*
- 2. You must complete the fingerprinting and they must fully process*
- 3. Your program, who provided you with these instructions, must recommend you. You will receive a system-generated email once your program has recommended you.*
- 4. Once your certificate has issued, you will be notified by email.*

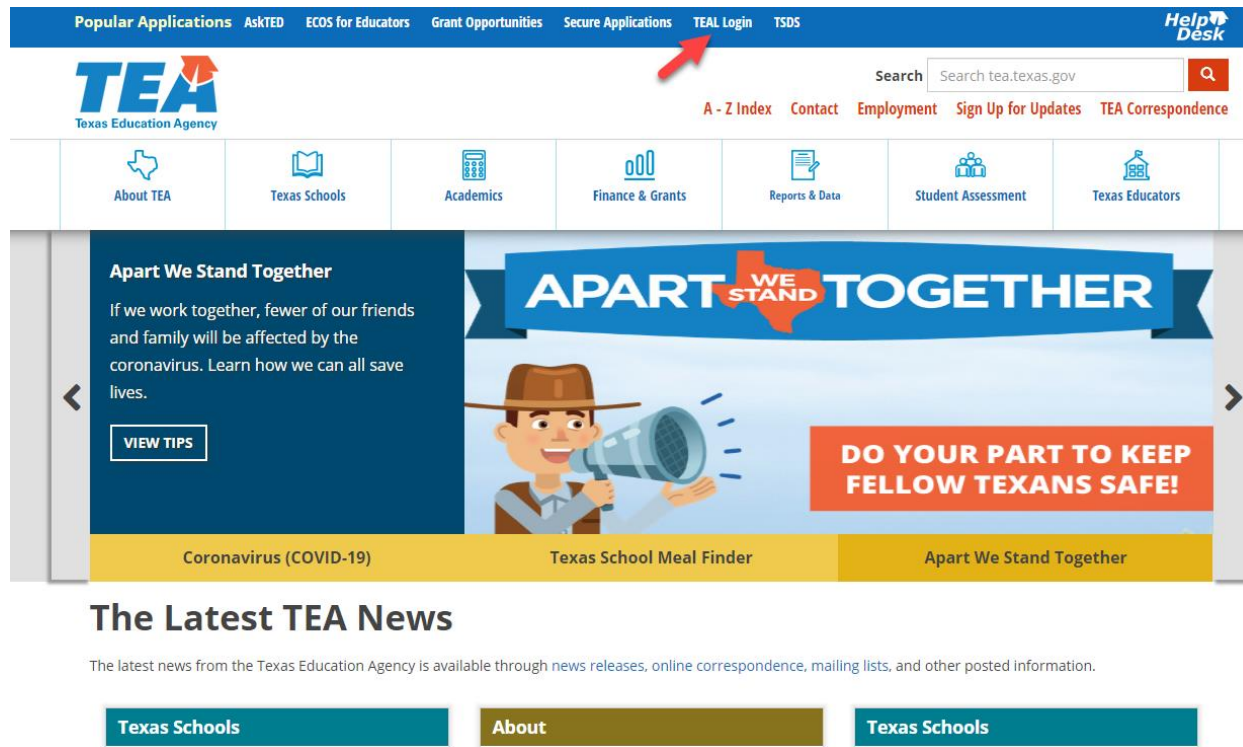
Quick start:

2. After logging in, click "Access Applications" on the Self-Service menu.

4. Verify your profile information and click on "Continue" to move to the next screen.

Educator Probationary Certification Menu

To receive an Intern Certificate, you must:

- Have been accepted to participate in a Texas approved educator preparation program.
- Have passed the required tests in the content areas for any certification sought. Classroom teaching areas also require a passed Pedagogy and Professional Responsibilities test.
- Have been assigned to serve in a supervised internship in the subject area and at the grade level of the certification sought.
- Pay a \$78 certification fee (Your application will be deleted if the required fee is not paid within 48 hours).
- Pass a criminal background check including a national fingerprint based background check.
- Pay a \$40.25 fingerprinting fee
