



_____ Angel Falls - The tallest waterfall in the world. Angel Falls drops 2,647 feet and is Venezuela's most popular attraction.

_____ Andes Mountains - The Andes are the longest mountain chain on Earth and the Highest in the Americas. Many of the peaks are active volcanoes.

_____ Atacama Desert - The Atacama is one of the driest places on Earth: in some parts, no rain has fallen in recorded history.

_____ Christ the Redeemer - A Christian symbol and cultural icon associated with both Rio de Janeiro and Brazil. It is listed as one of the New Seven Wonders of the World.

_____ Easter Island - Easter Island Maori Statues

_____ Lake Maracaibo - A large inland sea located in the western region of Venezuela. It is not a true lake in that it is open to the Caribbean Sea. It is considered the largest inland body of water in South America

____ Lake Titicaca - Is a lake located in the Andean region of the Altiplano on the border between Peru and Bolivia. It is considered the continent's largest freshwater lake.

____ Machu Picchu - Machu Picchu is believed to have been a royal estate or sacred religious site for Inca leaders in what is modern day Peru
